

- 90% of children aged 5-15 are online (Ofcom 2015)
- 11% of 9-16 year olds have encountered inappropriate images on the internet in the past 12 months
- 29% of UK children aged 9-16 years old said they had contact online with someone they have not met face to face (Ofcom 2013)
- 30% of 7-11 year olds reported having their own Facebook profiles before they are 13: the minimum age specified for membership (Broadbent, Green & Gardner, 2013)

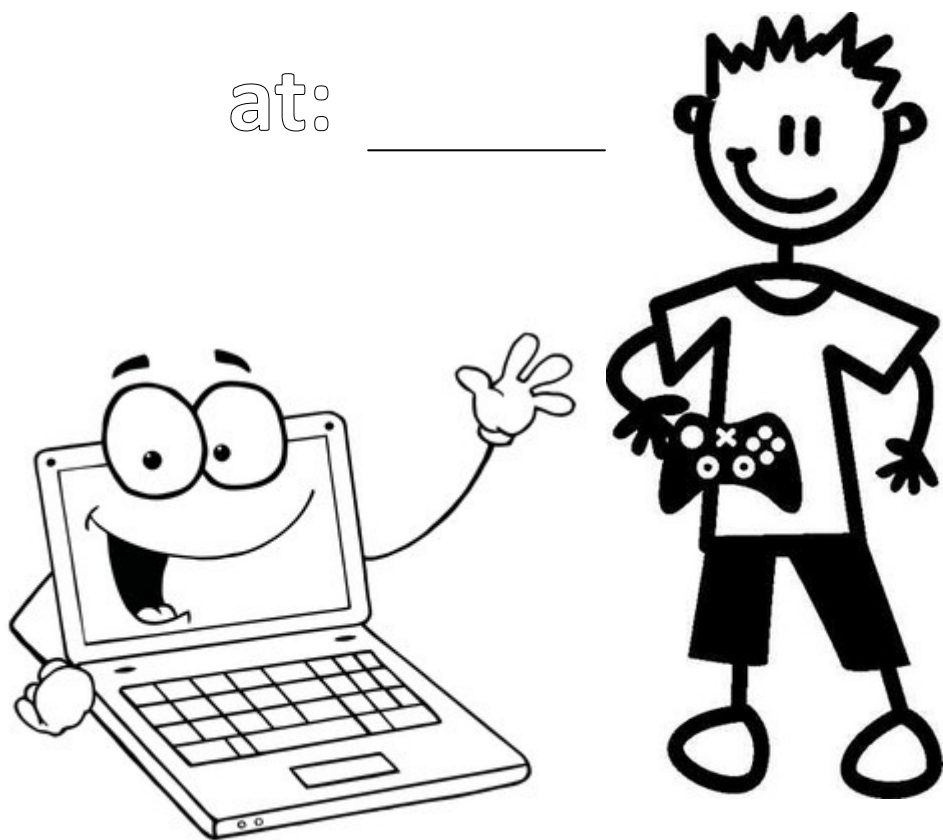
