Yearly Standardised Testing:

As you may already be aware schools historically have carried out standardized testing at the end of each school year in P3-P7. Data from this testing was used to build an academic profile on each child and allowed staff to track pupil progress from year to year throughout their time in our school.

Unfortunately, due to the closures last March and again this year, the continuity of such data is now broken, and schools somehow need to begin this process once again.

It has been decided that this year we will be carrying out standardized testing for Years 4-6.

We should emphasise that the results of these tests will <u>ONLY be used for baseline purposes within the school</u> and will help inform curriculum planning for next year.

Staff will reassure the children that there will be no need to worry or be anxious about these tests and that pupils will only be expected to do their best. Staff will supervise testing carefully to ensure no child is feels under any pressure.
